

Mayfield Centre Grand Opening

On Sunday 21 November the newly refurbished Mayfield Centre threw open its doors for its official grand opening.

Hundreds of residents took the opportunity to come and have a look at the first class facilities on offer. Also present was the Lord Mayor of Bradford Councillor Irene Ellison-Wood who revealed the commemorative plaque and praised the hard work of local people in realising the creation of the centre.

Jointly funded by Bradford Trident, The European Union through the European Regional Development Fund and with the help of Neighbourhood Renewal funds the project cost £1.7m to complete including the purchase of the land. Contractors Irwins helped out too by paying for the outdoor play equipment.

'A centre like this has long been needed in the neighbourhood. Myself and others have worked hard for many years to bring this project to fruition' says Bradford Trident Director Councillor Sher Khan. 'I am sure it will bring great benefits to the community for many years to come.'
